- No refunds are given (except for class cancellation). Transfers may be made to other classes where space is available.




June 11 - 15 & June 18—22; 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m., "Nature Hike I & II"


July 9—13 9 a.m.—1 p.m., "Galactic Heroes"


July 16 – 20 9:00 a.m.—1:00 p.m., “ Squared Away”


August 6-10, 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m., “Pages from the Past”


August 13—17; 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m., "Catching Creatures"
